

Internet Access Services for CUHK Alumni



Introduction

The Internet access service for CUHK alumni are to enable CUHK alumni to gain access to the Internet. The supported services are:

- Internet services such as E-mail, World-Wide Web (WWW), Usenet News, Telnet and File Transfer (FTP)
- A storage of 500MB for personal home page and email
- E-mail service with anti-spam and anti-virus feature accessible through POP, IMAP and webmail
- The above services can be accessed through other Internet Services Providers.
- Total 46 lines of V.90 56kbps modem for dial-up communication
- Unlimited wireless access within CUHK campus
(Note: No Unix shell account will be provided.)

The services charges are the following:

- Sign-up fee: **HK\$100 (Non-refundable)**
- Monthly charges: **HK\$ 20** (includes 5 hours of dial-up access time)
- Additional usage: **HK\$5 per hour**
- Unlimited usage: **HK\$200 per month**

The minimum subscription is 3 months. All CUHK Credit Card holders will have **30% discount** (Note: *The subscriber should be the holder of the credit card*).

Terms and Conditions

A. TERMS APPLIED

The following words apply to the whole context unless specified separately.

University

CU-Alumni-Net staff

Information Technology Services Centre staff responsible for the management of the Internet access services for CUHK alumni.

Subscriber

Any alumni who has requested to use the Internet access services for CUHK alumni.

B. DISCLAIMERS

- 2.1 CU-Alumni-Net staff cannot be held liable to the subscribers for any loss or damage of data arising directly or indirectly from the failure of hardware or software, or from human error, although the CU-Alumni-Net staff shall maintain procedures to prevent loss of data.
- 2.2 Although an appropriate effort is made to maintain system security, unauthorised access is possible through malicious mischief over the network. CU-Alumni-Net staff cannot guarantee against loss of privacy, theft of information, damage, or loss of data arising directly or indirectly from the absence or failure of system security protection mechanisms.
- 2.3 The University shall, at any time, not be liable for any loss, either directly or indirectly, of profits or revenues from subscribers who use the services.
- 2.4 Subscribers are responsible for obeying all official messages sent by E-mail, postal mail or fax, or displayed in the log-in message of the day.

C. USERS' RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 3.1 Only authorised subscribers may access the Internet access services for CUHK alumni. The right to use the CU-Alumni-Net is not transferable to anyone else.
- 3.2 Subscribers are responsible for selecting a secure password for his/her user ID and for securing that password at all time. In the event of theft or loss of password, the subscriber should report to CU-Alumni-Net staff with written notice within 48 hours.

3.3 Subscribers shall observe generally accepted rules related to proper use of Internet resources. CU-Alumni-Net staff reserves the right to restrict or terminate services provided to the subscriber who has violated the guidelines set forth by the University.

3.4 Subscribers are responsible, at all time, for using the service in a manner that is ethical, legal and not to the detriment of others. Harassing material may not be sent via electronic mail or posted to electronic forums and newsgroups.

3.5 Subscribers shall only use the services for their own personal interests. They shall not allow others to use their accounts for any purpose, such as commercial use.

D. SERVICES CHARGES AND PAYMENTS

4.1 Subscribers shall agree to pay for any charges, including initial sign-up fee, monthly charges and other service charges needed in order to use the Internet access services for CUHK alumni.

4.2 Subscribers shall receive a monthly statement on usage via electronic mail.

4.3 Payment shall only be made via the subscriber's VISA or Master credit card. All other payment methods such as autopay or cash are not accepted.

4.4 Subscribers shall notify, in the form of written notice, CU-Alumni-Net staff one month in advance, in case of change in payment methods or termination of subscription.

4.5 If the University cannot secure payment from the credit card centre for the subscriber's usage of the Internet access services after one month from the initial billing date, the subscriber's user ID will be terminated without further notice.
